8:45AM: check in for interviews in Middle School building (Junior, Teen, & Miss contestants)

JUNIOR CONTESTANTS

Junior contestants will participate in a 5 minute interview with our panel of judges. This is new for our juniors as of 2025. Girls will strictly be asked about themselves, things off of their application, and just basics festival questions.

Juniors attire for interview is Sunday best dress.

Makeup should be light and natural.

TEEN CONTESTANTS

Teen contestants will participate in a 7 minute interview with our panel of judges.

Attire will be Interview skirt Suit/interview appropriate dress, shoes & accessories (skirt – no pants; natural shoes or matching suit, natural makeup & hair away from the face.)

MISS CONTESTANTS

MISS contestants will participate in a 9 minute interview with our panel of judges.

Attire will be Interview skirt Suit/interview appropriate dress, shoes & accessories (skirt – no pants; natural shoes or matching suit, natural makeup & hair away from the face.)

Each contestant is allowed 1 guest with them for interviews. Please arrive dressed and ready for check in promptly at 8:45AM. Interviews will begin at 9AM in contestant number order and by each division.

6:30 PM: Contestants check in for the pageant.

There will be a space provided for contestants before and during the pageant. Feel free to use this

space for hair and makeup along with getting dressed.

This room will open at 3:30pm the day of pageant. We are limited to one room for all contestants. No more than 1 makeup person, 1 hair person, & 1 guest is allowed in contestant rooms before and

during pageant.

You are more than welcomed to get ready off of the festival grounds but must report to pageant

check in dressed and ready for 6:30pm

• Receive the official Tomato Queen Crown and Banner (Miss will receive train, mantle and scepter as

well)

• Be presented on stage at the Festival ASAP after crowning if the timing of bands allows

Sunday, April 27th, 2025 new queens will attend morning mass, will sign official contracts after

mass, and stay for the remaining of the festival

Judging Categories:

• Interview : 50 points

o contestants will be judged by a panel of judges. (Junior: 5 minutes Teen: 7 minutes &

Miss: 9 minutes)

Interview is the only time you are allowed to converse with the judges. We would like the judges to be able to focus on the contestant as an individual, how she carries herself, her answers, her knowledge of the area, the festival, and creole tomatoes. All contestants are asked to stay until every contestant is finished with their interviews. Then you will introduce yourself on the main festival stage if time allows (this introduction will not

be judged). Please remember an interview is just a conversation so relax, breathe and smile!

PAGEANT

• Stage Introduction: 25 points

Contestants will start the pageant on stage after a parade of Queens and constants. Each girl will do a short intro/jingle.

Create a jingle introducing yourself and inviting everyone to the Tomato Festival. This is something our Queens use throughout their reigns to invite everyone during their travels to our festival. Jingles may be no longer than 90 seconds.

- Creativity
- Personality
- o How well she depicts the Tomato Festival
- Speaking skills
- Confidence in front of a crowd

• Evening Gown – 25 points

- Stage personality
- Elegance & Grace
- Hair/makeup
- Attire
- Overall appearance

Evening gown should be floor length formal and appropriate for the event hosted by a catholic organization. It should also be age appropriate for the contestant. Makeup is appropriate for every contestant and hair is to your liking. During evening gown the girls will model on stage while their application/bio is read aloud by our MC.

• On Stage Question – 15 points (Miss Contestants Only)

- o Delivery of Answer
- Stage Presence
- o Content of Answer

Contestant will receive a list of possible questions after the interview. During the pageant after formalwear, the contestant will walk to the emcee. She will read the question twice, give you the paper so you can read the question and then the emcee will read it one more time aloud. The contestant will then answer the question and have a time limit of one and a half minutes to answer. Contestants do not have to use the entire time to answer.

• People's Choice. This is voted on by the audience. You can cast a vote for your favorite contestant at the pageant for just \$1 a vote. So tell everyone coming to bring their dollars to support their girl!

Director's Comments!

Each contestant should dress appropriately for her age and to represent a Catholic school/church organization that is Our Lady of Prompt Succor School & Church. Ear piercings will be the only piercings allowed while competing to be /reigning as a Tomato Queen. All tattoos if any must be covered and out of sight. Keep in mind your age and what you are competing to represent.
